



HEALTH PATIENT TRAVEL REMINDER

Patient Travel is a funded program through First Nations Health Authority (FNHA). The Medical Transportation Program provides **SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFITS** intended to ensure that eligible clients have access to medically-required services. It is not intended to cover all cost that may be associated with a client's medical condition and travel requirements.

FNHA GUIDELINES – FACTS:

Eligibility for medical transportation benefits for a specialist appointment. Client must provide the following documentation:

- Referral from a GP, family physician or other health professional,
- Confirmation of appointment from the health provider/health facility. Also,
- Client must provide confirmation of attendance from the health provider/health facility.
- Missing confirmation forms are one of the leading causes of patient travel cheque delays. Due to missing attendance documents from earlier appointments for that year. It is not the Health Clerk's responsibility to get these confirmations forms.
